This challenge is all about Maths Trails © Maths Trails are a great way to help learners to further develop their Maths Eyes and problem solving strategies.

What is a Maths trail?

A Maths trail is a walk through an area (can be indoors or outdoors) where people experience Maths in the real world. A Maths trail highlights the huge use of number we make in our everyday life and how Maths surrounds us even in the most unusual areas.
